
The Tudor Monarchs and Places



ACROSS

- 2 Elizabeth I, when she was "Lady Elizabeth" in Mary I's reign, was sent to this place under house arrest following her release from the Tower of London in 1554.
- 4 Henry VIII bought this property from Thomas Boleyn and renamed it Beaulieu.
- 5 Henry VII's father, Edmund Tudor, was Earl of this place.
- 8 Lady Jane Grey was tried at this London location on 13th November 1553 along with her husband, some of his brothers and Archbishop Cranmer.
- 9 Lady Jane Grey's father was duke of this English county.
- 11 Henry VIII died at this palace on 28th January 1547.
- 12 Henry VII was born at this castle on 28th January 1457.
- 14 This palace was built by Henry VIII in Surrey but was demolished in the late 17th century.
- 15 Birthplace of King Edward VI on 12th

October 1537.

- 16 Mary I married Philip of Spain here on 25th July 1554.
- 17 The palace that was the birthplace of Henry VIII, Mary I and Elizabeth I.

DOWN

- The name of the house and deer park in Leicestershire where Lady Jane Grey grew up.
- 2 Henry VIII is buried in this town.
- 3 Elizabeth I visited this castle belonging to Robert Dudley, Earl of Leicester, in 1575, staying there for 19 days.
- 6 The part of England loyal to Mary in July 1553 when she sought to depose Lady Jane Grey and take the throne as Mary I.
- 7 Resting place of Henry VII, Edward VI, Mary I and Elizabeth I.
- 10 Henry VII defeated Richard III at a battle near this town.
- 13 Elizabeth I was here when she learned that she was queen on 17th November 1558.
