
## Anne Boleyn's Life

- 11 This man pronounced the death sentences of Anne and her brother George at their trials in May 1536
- 14 Anne had a New Testament translated by this Reformer in her apartments
- 19 Before she was queen, Anne had this motto for a short
- time, Let them ......, it's the way it's going to be 20 Anne chose this bird, from her paternal grandfather's family, as her badge
- 21 In 1528, Anne came down with this illness but fortunately recovered
- 22 Anne's motto as queen
- 23 The name of the Anne's grandmother who lived with the Boleyns (first name and maiden name)
- 24 Anne was recalled from France in late 1521 as there were negotiations for her to marry this man

- 1 This man was the first arrest in Anne's fall in 1536
- Anne Boleyn's likely birthplace if she was born c.1501
- Anne's relationship with this man was broken up by Cardinal Wolsey
- In 1514, Anne was appointed to serve this Tudor woman
- This poet appears to have been in love with Anne
- Anne was crowned with this crown on 1st June 1533
- In her execution speech on 19th May 1536, Anne said "if any person will ....... of my cause, I require them to judge the best"
- 10 Anne gave birth to Elizabeth here
- 12 Anne had this boy as her ward
- 13 Anne's gaoler in May 1536
- 15 Anne went to Margaret of Austria's court here in 1513
- 16 Anne was chosen to serve this French queen in 1515
- 17 It is thought that Anne played this part at the 1522 Chateau Vert pageant
- 18 Anne Boleyn's mother, Elizabeth, was buried at St Mary's Church, .....
