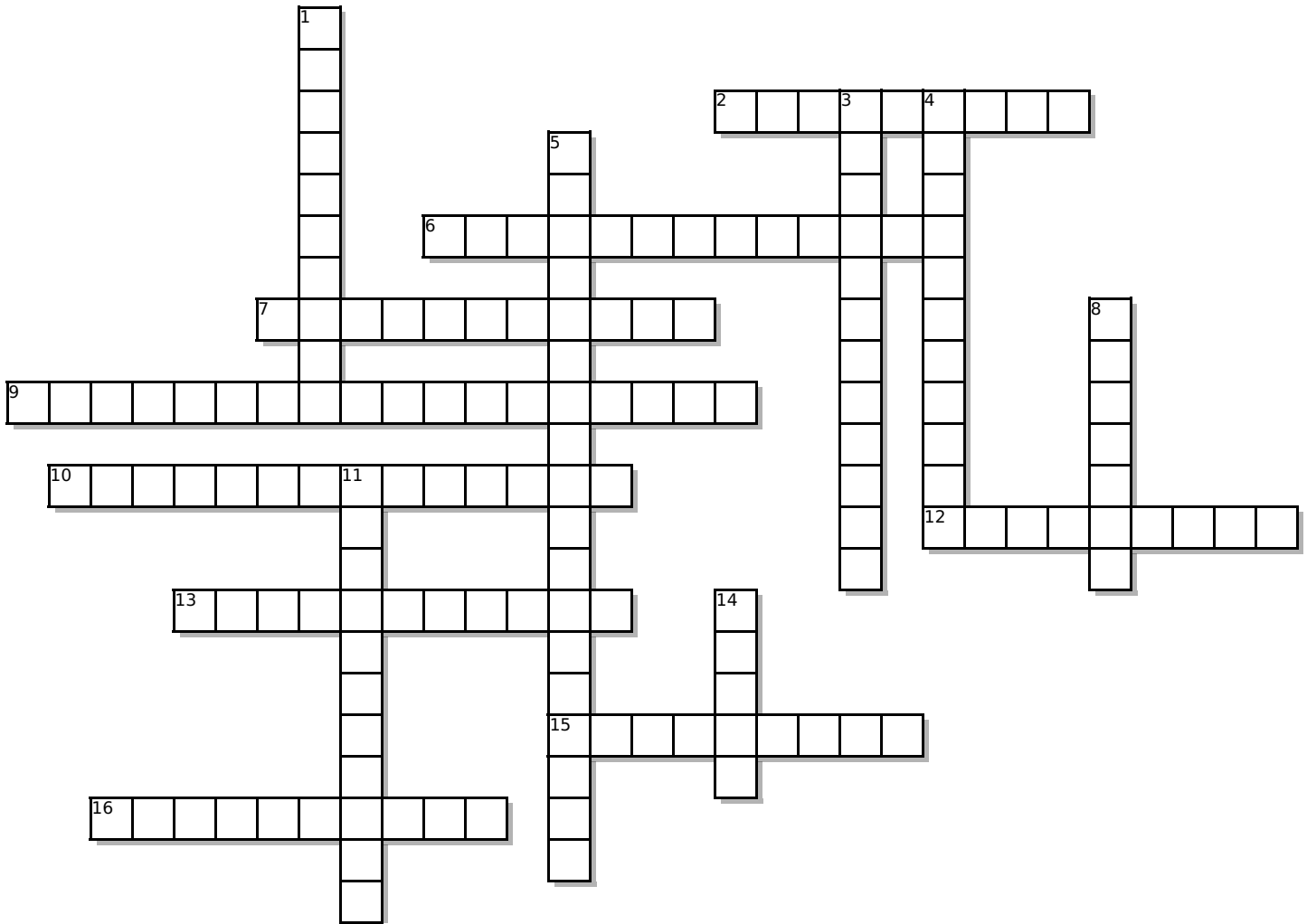


Henry VIII Crossword Puzzle 2



ACROSS

- 2 Henry married his third wife, Jane Seymour, at this palace in 1536.
- 6 This man convened a special court at Dunstable Priory which ruled that the king's first marriage was invalid.
- 7 The of the monasteries saw nearly 900 religious houses being closed.
- 9 This widowed princess and duchess was considered as a potential bride for Henry after the death of Jane Seymour.
- 10 This man was Henry VIII's close friend and brother-in-law.
- 12 This 1534 act recognised Henry as head of the church in England.
- 13 These fortifications were built by Henry VIII to defend the coastlines of England and Wales.
- 15 Henry used a verse from this Old Testament book to argue his case for an annulment of his first marriage.

- 16 This lawyer led the 1536 Pilgrimage of Grace rebellion and was executed in 1537.

DOWN

- 1 Monks of this order of the London Charterhouse were martyred after they refused to recognise the king as head of the Church.
- 3 This royal advisor fell from power in 1529, charged with praemunire.
- 4 This groom of the stool and friend of the king was executed in 1536 in the fall of Anne Boleyn.
- 5 Birthplace of the king's son, Edward VI, and where Jane Seymour died.
- 8 Jane Seymour gave birth to the king's son in this month of 1537.
- 11 A special legatine court met here to consider the king's Great Matter.
- 14 Henry VIII's 1521 "Defence of the Seven Sacraments" led to the pope giving him the title of Defender of the

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
